NOTICE: Per Comptroller Counsel, we cannot process a Notice of Contest of Lien if the lien is an IRS Lien or any other Government Lien.

- 1. **Only** the owner or **attorney** for the owner can contest the lien.
- 2. The name and address must be printed below the signature.

Note: Please be sure to include the document number of the lien that is being contested in the body of the "Notice of Contest of Lien".

Certificate of Mailing - \$20
