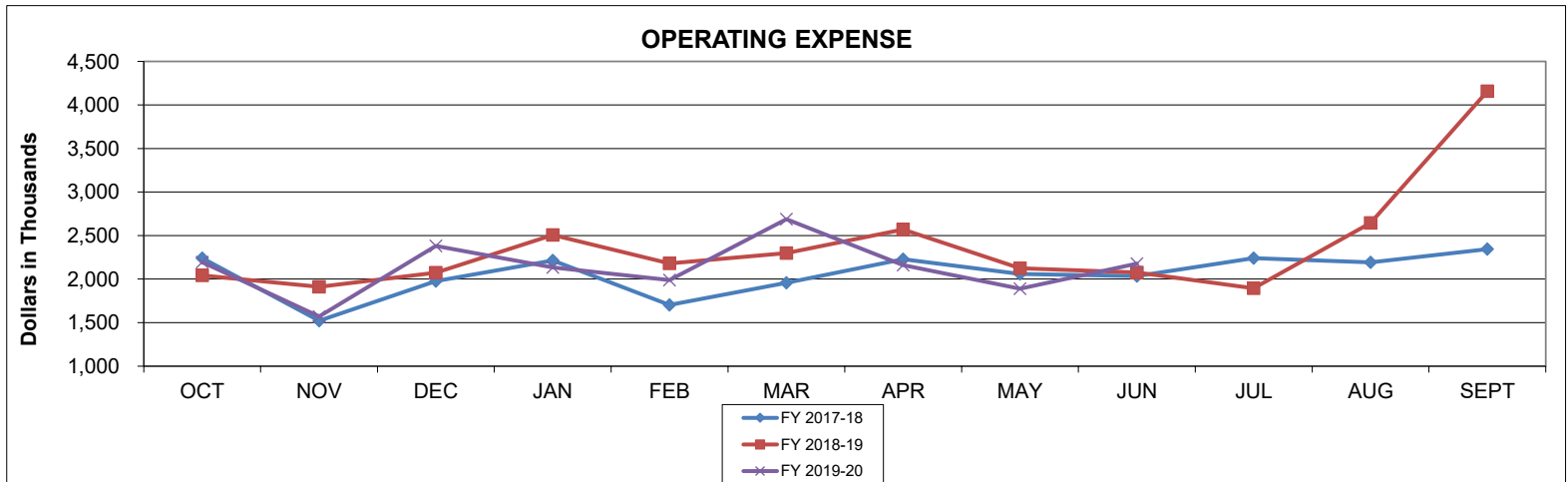
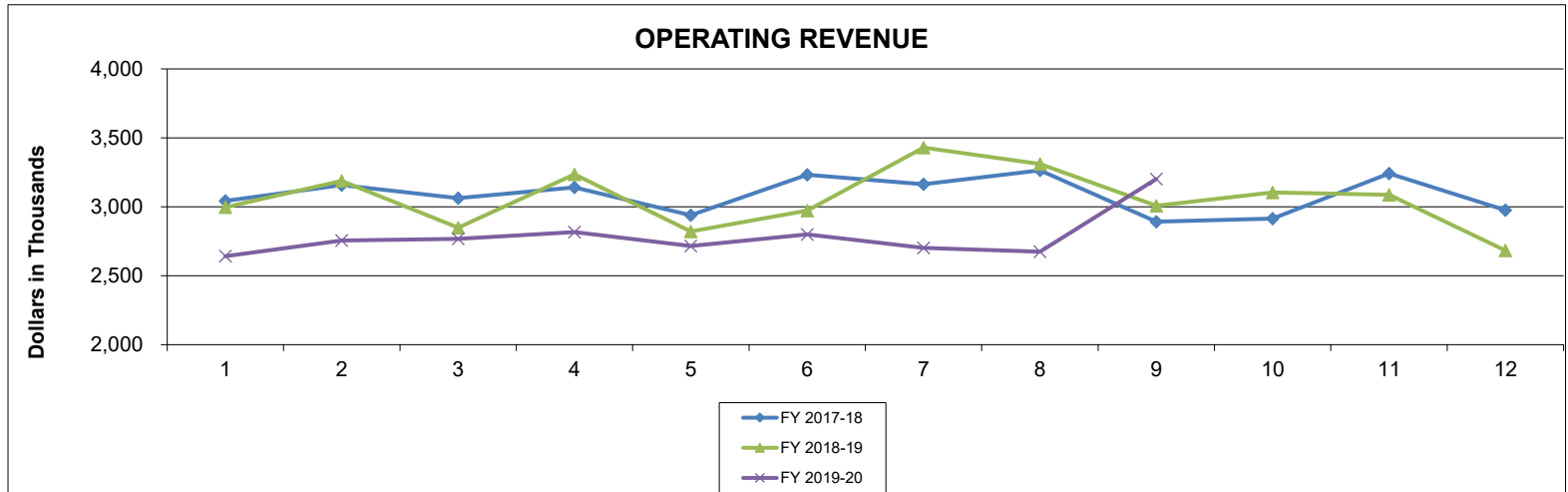

To more accurately reflect the performance during FY2018 and FY2019 closure expense has been reallocated from October 2017 through August 2018 by reducing each month by an average of \$7K; and from October 2018 through August 2019 reducing each month by an average of \$36K. Since it has been recalculated, graphical presentation will not correspond to the respective monthly interims, as previously presented.
