BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' DETERMINATION
UNDER SECTION 2, ORDINANCE NO. 79-32

FINDINGS

1. The Board of County Commissioners is considering the adoption of regulations that provide a methodology for determining the normal high water elevation.

2. These regulations shall be used to establish construction setback lines under Article II of the Orange County Zoning Resolution, to establish boundaries for regulating dredge and fill under Articles II, III, IV, and V, Chapter 36, Orange County Code, and determine minimum floor levels under Section 13, Article XXV, Orange County Zoning Resolution.

3. Since these regulations will be used to assist the enforcement of existing County laws or regulations, they should have no economic impact on the development of real property in Orange County.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
ORANGE COUNTY;

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners does hereby determine and find, pursuant to Section 2(a), Orange County Ordinance No. 79-32, that the adoption of the Orange County Surface Water Boundary Regulations will not have a substantial economic impact on the development of real property in Orange County.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners does hereby determine and find that no further economic impact statement or economic impact information is required in this matter.
