RESOLUTION NO. 91-LEG-02

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2 A RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING OPPOSITION OF THE
3 BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO THE
4 ENACTMENT BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
5 FLORIDA OF STATUTES WHICH WOULD MANDATE
6 STATE CONTROL OF OR REGULATION OVER COUNTY
7 IMPACT FEE PROGRAMS.

8 WHEREAS, a proposed bill known as House Bill 2261 has
9 been introduced into the present session of the Legislature
10 of the State of Florida; and

11 WHEREAS, the said House Bill 2261, if enacted, would
12 create state regulations and govern the local administration
13 of county impact fees and county impact fee revenue by such
14 state regulations; and

15 WHEREAS, the said House Bill 2261 is but a single example
16 of the numerous legislative proposals of similar legislation
17 designed to infringe upon, restrict or unnecessarily regulate
18 the implementation or administration of county impact fee
19 programs; and

20 WHEREAS, county wide impact fee programs are programs
21 which by their localized nature and purpose should be
22 amenable only to county legislation; and

23 WHEREAS, Orange County has implemented and currently
24 administrates an impact fee program and impact fee payment
25 system which is just, equitable and administratively
26 efficient and such impact fee program and payment system does
27 not require further infringement, regulation, restriction or
28 state supervision such as would be mandated under the
29 provisions of the said House Bill 2261 or any similar
30 legislation; and

31 WHEREAS, the Orange County Office of Management and
32 Budget has reviewed the provisions of the said House Bill
33 2261 and provisions found in other similar bills and finds
34 therein language which would be prejudicial to the efficient
35 and economic execution of Orange County's impact fee program
36 and the administration thereof.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida does hereby voice its opposition to the enactment by the Legislature of the State of Florida of House Bill 2261 or any similar legislation proposed which would infringe upon county impact fee programs or regulate or restrict or subject such county impact fee programs to state supervision.

Section 2. The Clerk to this Board is hereby instructed to provide copies of this Resolution to members of the Orange County Legislative Delegation and the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate of the Florida Legislature.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
