9 **RATES FOR TOWING AND ADMINISTRATIVE FEES**

11 **Resolution No. 2001-M-49**

13 WHEREAS, Chapter 35, Orange County Code, sets forth the maximum rates for trespass towing and maximum administrative fees; and

15 WHEREAS, the method of establishing maximum rates for all vehicle owner non-consensual and police agency towing services, private or public, shall be by Resolution of the Orange County Board of County Commissioners; and

19 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County, its citizens and its visitors, to regulate the maximum rates charged for non-consensual towing services.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
23 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY.

25 Section 1. The Schedule of Maximum Rates that can be charged for Class A trespass towing and "non-consensual" towing service is hereby amended to read:

27 CLASS A VEHICLES [Gross vehicle weight through 10,000 pounds or vehicle carrying a vessel 15 feet or less in length].

31 Section 2. The maximum rate for administrative fees for all classes of vehicles is amended to read:

An administrative fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) may be charged after  
33 the first forty-eight (48) hours of fee storage so long as the Towing Service  
has actually complied with the requirements of Section 78, Chapter 713,  
35 Florida Statutes, including execution and mailing of the lien notice.

Section 3. All other fees and charges not specifically amended herein shall remain in effect.

37 Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any  
person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this  
39 Resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the  
provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

41 Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
