WHEREAS, trees are an important part of our Orange County community; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to apply for a 2005 Emergency Hurricane Supplemental Urban and Community Forestry Grant, which would provide monies to Orange County to replace trees that were destroyed by recent hurricanes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wants to enter into a 2005 Emergency Hurricane Supplemental Urban and Community Forestry Grant Program Grant Memorandum of Agreement and Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement between Orange County and the State of Florida, Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Forestry;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Board of County Commissioners approves filing an application for the 2005 Emergency Hurricane Supplemental Urban and Community Forestry Grant.

SECTION 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes Orange County, through its Mayor, County Administrator and/or designees, to file an application and, if eligible, enter into a 2005 Emergency Hurricane Supplemental Urban and Community Forestry Grant Program Grant Memorandum of Agreement and an Urban and Community Forestry Grant

Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement between Orange County and the State of Florida's Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Forestry.


SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.
