**A RESOLUTION OF THE ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS IN SUPPORT OF LYNX SERVICES ON LINK 30;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, many residents of Orange County use the Central Florida Regional Transportation Authority (hereinafter "LYNX") services; and

WHEREAS, daily commutes in Orange County by residents using personal motor vehicles contribute to the congestion of an already overburdened roadway system; and

WHEREAS, LYNX is considering the possibility of extending service in Orange County on Link 30, an existing cross-town route serving almost the entire county (which is primarily East-West by its boundaries) along Colonial Drive (S.R. 50) from the West Oaks Mall to the University of Central Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners, contingent upon revenue availability, supports provision of local funds to match the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Service Development Grant funds proposed to provide service on the LYNX Link 30 for fiscal year 2008.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
