

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Chapter 373 of the Florida States known as the Florida Resources Act of 1972 identifies the St. Johns River Water Management District and delegates certain authority and responsibility to that District concerning water resources in the State of Florida, and

WHEREAS, a portion of Orange County is contained within the District and comes under the rules and regulations of said District, and

WHEREAS, The District has requested local governments to submit proposals for District assistance in investigating water resource problems of mutual interest to the District and the participating agencies, and


WHEREAS, Orange and Seminole Counties have established a mutual need to study the Little Wekiva Drainage Basin and have prepared a joint application to the District, and

WHEREAS, The District has received several thousand dollars in tax revenue from Orange County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County request that the St. Johns River Water Management District include in its 1982-1983 budget, funds for a study of the Little Wekiva Drainage Basin as outlined in the attached application.
