

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A GOAL
TO ASSIST IN THE LONG-RANGE
PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A
SYSTEM OF OBSTETRICAL SERVICES
FOR MATERNITY AND INFANT CARE
PATIENTS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County recognizes and is committed to a partnership with the health providers in Orange County for the provision of health care services to the maternity and infant care patients of the Orange County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, this partnership will take the form of Orange County providing out-patient services and financial participation in the cost of obstetrical services; and

WHEREAS, it is also understood that any change in the current system of service will require a lengthy planning and implementation period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That a goal be established to assist in the long-range planning and implementation of a system of service delivery which is both cost-effective for the citizens of Orange County and provides for shared responsibility of the health providers in Orange County for the obstetrical services of the maternity and infant care patients.

SECTION 2. That all area hospitals be advised of the County's intention in this respect,
