ORANGE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 84-LEG-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA; APPOINTING A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE BOARD TO CONTACT AND MEET WITH A GROWTH MANAGEMENT LEGISLATIVE TASK FORCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida, has been made aware of the formation of a private task force to develop proposed amendments to the growth management and land use regulation laws of the State of Florida.


2. It is in the best interest of the citizens of Orange County, Florida, for the Board to have input as soon as reasonably possible in the development of growth management and land use regulation legislation which may be considered by the 1985 Florida Legislature.

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:


