

A RESOLUTION CONVEYING CERTAIN OBSOLETE COUNTY
FIRE EQUIPMENT TO THE CITY OF WINTER GARDEN FIRE
DEPARTMENT, A MUNICIPALITY OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA

PREMISES

1. The Board of County Commissioners is in receipt of the application of the City of Winter Garden Fire Department for conveyance to it of obsolete fire equipment which is presently County property.

2. The Board of County Commissioners finds that the said City of Winter Garden Fire Department is a valid and subsisting municipality of the State of Florida and that among the purposes expressed in the application of said municipality is to "assist the Orange County Fire Department on a mutual aid basis".

3. The Board of County Commissioners has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain obsolete fire fighting equipment, namely,

and One 1959 Dodge D300 truck tank

which property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

4. The Board of County Commissioners, by virtue of Section 125.38 Fla. Stat., is authorized to convey obsolete County property no longer of use to or required by the County to Florida municipalities.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

THAT, Orange County shall and hereby does convey to the City of Winter Garden Fire Department, the following described property for the value stated, namely:

and that the County Administrator be, and hereby is, authorized to execute on behalf of the County all documents necessary to accomplish transfer of title thereto.
