RESOLUTION NO. 85-M-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION OF COLLEGE PARK TOWERS II, INC. FOR FUNDING UNDER SECTION 202 OF THE HOUSING ACT OF 1959 FOR PROVISION OF HOUSING FOR ELDERLY CITIZENS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the County Commission is aware of a need for suitable housing for many of the county's retired citizens of low-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, continuing inflation creates hardship on elderly citizens, many of whom live on fixed incomes; and

WHEREAS, Section 202 of the Housing Act of 1959, as amended, provides for low interest, long-term, direct mortgage financing by the United State Department of Housing and Urban Development for the development and construction and operation of non-profit housing facilities, designed and restricted to occupancy by low-moderate income, elderly persons; and

WHEREAS, under the sponsorship of College Park Baptist Church a 102-unit Section 202 housing facility, College Park Towers, has been previously developed and has contributed significantly to addressing the housing and related needs of low-moderate income elderly citizens of Orange County; and

WHEREAS, despite the success and mission-accomplishment of College Park Towers, additional housing and related care facilities are needed to meet the needs of our elderly citizens,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the application of College Park Towers II, Inc. to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for funding under Section 202 for the development of 56 additional units of housing for the elderly is hereby supported.
