RESOLUTION NO. 86-M-28

WHEREAS, Section 197.072(3), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to file minimum tax notices upon the recommendation of the County Tax Collector; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector of Orange County has so recommended to the Board the adoption of said procedure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 197.072(3), Florida Statutes, the Commission hereby instructs the Tax Collector of Orange County not to mail notices to any taxpayer when the amount of the taxes shown on the tax notice is less than \$5.00. The Commission further instructs the Property Appraiser of Orange County, Florida, not to make an extension on the tax roll for any parcel for which the tax will amount to less than \$5.00; that said instruction to the said Tax Collector and Property Appraiser shall apply to the 1986 tax roll and subsequent rolls.
