2 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
3 AND THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE
4 ORLANDO-ORANGE COUNTY "COMMISSION ON THE BICENTENNIAL
5 OF THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION"; TO COORDINATE
6 LOCAL AND REGIONAL COMMEMORATIVE ACTIVITIES TO BE
7 PRESENTED THROUGHOUT 1987 AND CULMINATING ON SEPTEMBER
8 17, 1987; TO DEVELOP AND APPROVE PLANS FOR A
9 COMMEMORATIVE PROGRAM; TO ENCOURAGE CITIZENS WITHIN
10 MUNICIPALITIES AND THROUGHOUT ORANGE COUNTY TO PARTICI-
11 PATE IN THE CELEBRATION OF THE 200TH ANNIVERSARY OF
12 THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION; TO SEEK RECOGNITION AS
13 A DESIGNATED BICENTENNIAL COMMUNITY; PROVIDING FOR
14 CONCURRENCE AS TO MEMBERSHIP; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida,
16 and the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida, desire to create
17 a joint Commission on the Bicentennial of the United States Constitution;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, these two local governing bodies recognize the Bicentennial
20 Celebration as an event of historic magnitude and wish to work together
21 to coordinate community groups and individual volunteers in the planning
22 of events and programs throughout this area; and

23 WHEREAS, the Bicentennial Celebration will begin early in 1987, and
24 will culminate on September 17 in remembrance of the adoption of the
25 Constitution by all 12 states delegations on that date in 1787; and

26 WHEREAS, the joint city/county commission will work together to
27 develop and approve plans of various groups and organizations who will
28 be asked to participate in the projects for this celebration; and

29 WHEREAS, the joint Commission on the Bicentennial of the United
30 States Constitution, upon approval of this resolution, will submit a
31 request to the national Commission for recognition as one of the original
32 Designated Bicentennial Communities; and

33 WHEREAS, the membership of this Orlando-Orange County Commission
34 will be established by concurrence of the Board of County Commissioners
35 of Orange County, Florida, and the City Council of the City of Orlando;

36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
AND THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, that a joint Commission on the Bicen-
ennial of the United States Constitution is hereby established and will
become effective upon passage.
