RESOLUTION NO. 87-F/EMS-05

A RESOLUTION CONVEYING OBSOLETE COUNTY
FIRE EQUIPMENT TO LAKE COUNTY, A DIVISION
OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF THE STATE OF
FLORIDA.

PREMISES

1. The Orange County Commission is in receipt of the application of Lake County for conveyance to it of obsolete fire equipment which is presently County property.

2. The Orange County Commission finds that the said Lake County is a valid division of local government of the State of Florida.

3. The Orange County Commission has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain obsolete fire fighting equipment, namely:

which property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

4. The Orange County Commission, by virtue of Section 125.38 Florida Statutes, is authorized to convey obsolete County property no longer of use to or required by the County, to other political subdivisions of the State of Florida.

and the County Administrator, be and hereby is, authorized to execute on behalf of the County all documents necessary to accomplish transfer of title thereto.
