1 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
2 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY,
3 FLORIDA, DISSOLVING THE ORANGE COUNTY
4 CITIZENS CHARTER GOVERNMENT STUDY
5 COMMITTEE AND CREATING THE ORANGE
6 COUNTY CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION.

7 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange
8 County, Florida did on April 14, 1986 pursuant to Resolution
9 86-M-13 create the Orange County Citizens Charter Government
10 Study Committee; and

11 WHEREAS, the work of said Committee has been completed
12 and resulted in the passage of the Orange County Charter
13 which became effective on January 1, 1987; and

14 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is now requir-
15 ed pursuant to Article VII of the Charter to create a Charter
16 Review Commission, now, therefore

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
18 ORANGE COUNTY,

19 Section 1. Dissolution. The Orange County Citizens
20 Charter Government Study Committee created on April 14, 1986
21 pursuant to Resolution 86-M-13 is declared to have fulfilled
22 its charge and is hereby dissolved.

23 Section 2. Membership. Pursuant to Article VII of
24 the Orange County Charter the Orange County Charter Review
25 Commission is created. The membership of the Commission
26 shall consist of 15 members. All members of the Charter
27 Review Commission shall be electors of the County. No elect-
28 ed official shall be appointed as a member of the Charter
29 Review Commission.

30 The initial appointees to the Charter Review Commission
31 shall be as follows:

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11 All initial members of the Charter Review Commission
12 shall serve until January 1, 1989. Upon completion of the
13 initial term a member may be reappointed by the Board of
14 County Commissioners. All terms after the initial term shall
15 be for a period of four years as prescribed by Article VII of
16 the Charter. The Board of County Commissioners shall appoint
17 the new membership prior to January 1 of each four year term
18 commencing with the first four year term on January 1, 1989.

19 Section 3. Duties. The Charter Review Commission
20 shall be empowered to conduct a comprehensive study of any or
21 all phases of County government. A report of proposed amend-
22 ments and revisions of the Charter shall be presented by the
23 Charter Review Commission to the Board of County
24 Commissioners no later than August 1, 1988. Any proposed
25 amendments or revisions to the Charter shall be placed on the
26 ballot in November of 1988, and in four-year cycles
27 thereafter, without the approval of the Board of County
28 Commissioners of Orange County, Florida. The Charter Review
29 Commission shall present any proposed amendments or
30 revisions to the Board of County Commissioners no later than
31 August 1 of the fourth year of every four-year cycle after
32 1988.

33 Section 4. Procedures. The Charter Review
34 Commission shall create and elect appropriate officers and

1 shall enact such procedures as it deems necessary and proper
2 for the orderly conduct of its specific duties.

3 Section 5. Expenses. The Board of County
4 Commissioners shall defray reasonable expenses of the Charter
5 Review Commission subject to any limitations imposed by the
6 annual County budgetary process.

7 Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall
8 become effective upon the date of passage.
