RESOLUTION OF THE ORANGE COUNTY COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF THE LAS ALAMEDAS HOUSING PROJECT AS BEING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ORANGE COUNTY GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLAN AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE DEVELOPMENT THEREOF.

WHERE AS, The Orange County Commission desires and encourages the development of affordable housing for the residents of the unincorporated area known as Plymouth.

WHERE AS, The Farmworker Association of Central Florida desires to develop the Las Alamedas housing project in the Plymouth Area thus providing affordable housing for low-and moderate-income persons.

WHERE AS, The Project is in compliance with the Countys' Growth Management Policy and its' applicable regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ORANGE COUNTY COMMISSION THAT THE LAS ALAMEDAS PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH COUNTY PLANS, PROGRAMS AND OBJECTIVES.
