1 RESOLUTION OF THE ORANGE COUNTY COMMISSION
2 PROVIDING THAT THE ORANGE COUNTY
3 COMMISSION SUGGEST THAT THE COUNTY
4 ADMINISTRATOR IN HONOR OF DR. MARTIN
5 LUTHER KING, JR.'S BIRTHDAY INCLUDE THE
6 THIRD MONDAY IN JANUARY IN THE PACKAGE OF
7 RECOMMENDED HOLIDAYS FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES
8 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

9 WHEREAS, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was a prominent
10 civil rights leader.

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. won the Nobel Peace
12 Prize in 1964.

13 WHEREAS, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. had a tremendous
14 impact on the racial fabric of American society.

15 WHEREAS, the Orange County Commission desires to honor
16 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday by suggesting to the
17 County Administrator that the third Monday in January be
18 included in the County Administrator's package of recommended
19 holidays for Orange County employees.

20 WHEREAS, Section 125.01(1)(t), Florida Statutes
21 authorizes the governing body of a county to adopt
22 resolutions necessary for the exercise of its powers.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ORANGE COUNTY
24 COMMISSION

25 Section 1. The Orange County Commission, in honor of Dr.
26 Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday hereby suggests that the
27 County Administrator include the third Monday in January in
28 the package of recommended holidays for Orange County
29 employees.

30 Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take
31 effect upon adoption.
