RESOLUTION NO. 88-M-92

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED  
LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR FOR THE RESI-  
DENTIAL DISTRICT KNOWN AS SOUTHWOOD SUBDIVISION  
Sections 1, 2,3,4,5A,5B,5C,5D,5E,5F,5G.

WHEREAS, Section 316.189 and Section 316.183, Florida  
Statutes, as amended by Chapter 88-47, Laws of Florida,  
authorizes a county to set a maximum speed limit of 25 miles  
per hour for a residential district after an investigation  
determines that such a limit is reasonable; and

WHEREAS, Orange County has determined after an investi-  
gation that the maximum speed limit should be 25 miles per  
hour for the residential district known as SOUTHWOOD SUBDIVISION  
Sections 1,2,3,4,5A,5B,5C,5D,5E,5F,5G

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COM-  
MISSION OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. The maximum speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour  
for all streets located within the residential district known  
as SOUTHWOOD SUBDIVISION. Sections 1,2,3,4,5A,5B,5C,5D,5E,5F,5G.

2. This Resolution shall become effective upon the  
date of its adoption.

However, we will be pleased with any reduction in the the thirty mile limit, which is presently posted.


