2 A RESOLUTION AMENDING ORANGE COUNTY
3 RESOLUTION NO. 88-M-22; CHANGING THE NAME
4 "ORANGE COUNTY COMMISSION" TO "BOARD OF
5 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY,
6 FLORIDA" IN ORANGE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO.
7 88-M-22; AMENDING SECTION 2(b) OF ORANGE
8 COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 88-M-22 TO PROVIDE
9 THAT THE TERM OF MEMBERSHIP ON THE ORANGE
10 COUNTY AFFORDABLE HOUSING TASK FORCE SHALL
11 BE ONE (1) YEAR AND FOUR (4) MONTHS
12 COMMENCING ON MAY 1, 1988 AND TERMINATING ON
13 AUGUST 31, 1989; AMENDING SECTION 4 OF
14 ORANGE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 88-M-22 TO
15 PROVIDE THAT THE ORANGE COUNTY AFFORDABLE
16 HOUSING TASK FORCE SHALL SUBMIT A FINAL
17 WRITTEN REPORT TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY
18 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ON
19 AUGUST 31, 1989; PROVIDING THAT ALL OTHER
20 PROVISIONS OF ORANGE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO.
21 88-M-22 SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED; AND
22 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

23 WHEREAS, on April 25, 1988, the Board of County
24 Commissioners of Orange County, Florida, adopted Orange
25 County Resolution No. 88-M-22 which created the Orange County
26 Affordable Housing Task Force;

27 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange
28 County, Florida, desires to amend Orange County Resolution
29 No. 88-M-22 to extend the term of membership on the Orange
30 County Affordable Housing Task Force;

31 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange
32 County, Florida, desires to amend Orange County Resolution
33 No. 88-M-22 to change the date that the Orange County
34 Affordable Housing Task Force submits its final written
35 report to the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County,
36 Florida; and

WHEREAS, Section 125.01(1)(t), Florida Statutes, provides
in pertinent part that the governing body of a county may
adopt resolutions necessary for the exercise of its powers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The name "Orange County Commission" is
hereby changed to the "Board of County Commissioners of
Orange County, Florida" in Orange County Resolution No.
88-M-22.

1 Section 2. Section 2(b) of Orange County Resolution No.
2 88-M-22 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 Sec. 2. Membership.

4 (b) The members of the Task Force shall be
5 appointed for a term of one (1) year
6 and four (4) months, commencing on May
7 1, 1988, and terminating on ~~April-30,~~
8 1989 August 31, 1989.

9 Section 3. Section 4 of Orange County Resolution No.
10 88-M-22 is hereby amended to read as follows:

11 Sec. 4. Reports.

12 The Task Force shall submit written reports
13 to the Board of County Commissioners of
14 Orange County, Florida, on or before
15 September 1, 1988 and February 1, 1989,
16 outlining its preliminary findings. The
17 Task Force shall submit a final written
18 report to the Board of County Commissioners
19 of Orange County, Florida, on or before
20 ~~April-30, 1989~~ August 31, 1989, outlining
21 its findings and recommendations as to
22 viable means, methods and options for
23 providing adequate and affordable housing to
24 the citizens of Orange County.

25 Section 4. Existing Provisions. All other provisions
26 of Orange County Resolution No. 88-M-22 shall remain
27 unchanged.

28 Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution amending
29 Orange County Resolution No. 88-M-22 shall become effective
30 upon the date of passage.
