

1 RESOLUTION NO. 89-M-31

2 RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF
4 NATURAL RESOURCES TO GRANT AN EASEMENT TO
5 CONSTRUCT BRIDGES.

6 WHEREAS, the Orange County Public Works Division is in
7 need of a public easement to construct two (2) bridge
8 structures crossing the Little Econlockhatchee River on Dean
9 Road as part of the Dean Road improvement project from State
10 Road 50 to University Boulevard; and

11 WHEREAS, title to the property is vested in the State
12 Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund and
13 administered by the State of Florida Department of Natural
14 Resources; and

15 WHEREAS, pursuant to Rule 18-21.009 of the Florida
16 Administrative Code an application for a public easement
17 request by a local government agency shall be by formal
18 resolution.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
20 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA;

21 Section 1. That the Board of County Commissioners does
22 hereby formally request the State of Florida Department of
23 Natural Resources to grant to it a permanent public easement
24 for the purpose of constructing and maintaining two (2)
25 bridge structures crossing the Little Econlockhatchee River
26 on Dean Road as part of the Dean Road improvement project
27 from State Road 50 to University Boulevard. The real
28 property description for which the easement is requested is
29 as follows:

30 LEGAL DESCRIPTION

31 A PORTION OF SECTION 18 AND 19, TOWNSHIP 22
32 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, ORANGE COUNTY,
33 FLORIDA. BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED
34 AS:

35 COMMENCE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION
36 19, TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, ORANGE
37 COUNTY, FLORIDA. RUN THENCE S00°31'43"E,
38 ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SAID SECTION 19, A
39 DISTANCE OF 1,011.54 FEET, FOR THE POINT OF
40 BEGINNING; THENCE N89°28'17"E, A DISTANCE OF
41 110.00 FEET; THENCE S00°31'43"E, A DISTANCE

5 DISTANCE OF 110.00 FEET; THENCE N00°31'43"W,

7 N89°28'17"E, A DISTANCE OF 110.00 FEET; TO
8 THE EAST LINE OF SAID SECTION 18; THENCE
9 N00°31'43"W ALONG SAID EAST LINE, A DISTANCE
10 OF 205.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

11 CONTAINING 92,950 SQUARE FEET OR 2.134 ACRES
12 MORE OR LESS.

13 Section 2. That the Board of County Commissioners does
14 hereby formally request that the State of Florida Department
15 of Natural Resources waive the \$200.00 processing fee for
16 this application for public easement pursuant to Rule
17 18-21.009(1)(g), F.A.C.

18 Section 3. That a copy of this Resolution shall be
19 transmitted by the Orange County Public Works Division to the
20 State of Florida Department of Natural Resources with the
21 application for easement.

22 Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon
23 adoption.

PUBLIC EASEMENT FOR DEAN ROAD BRIDGES

Public Works requires an easement and waiver of fees to construct two bridges crossing the Little Econlockhatchee River. The construction is part of the Dean Road improvement project from SR 50 to University Boulevard. Title to this waterway is vested in the State Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund and is administered by the Department of Natural Resources. As part of the easement/permitting process, the Commission must pass a resolution requesting the easement and waiver of fees as well as stating the type and purpose of the easement. It is requested that the Commission adopt this resolution.
