WHEREAS, the Orange County Schools have numerous facilities available for use after school hours; and

WHEREAS, the 1989 Orange County Parks and Recreation Department Survey conducted by the University of Central Florida, Institute of Statistics, shows overwhelming county-wide support for before and after school youth programs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Purpose of Resolution.

That the Orange District School Board and the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida hold meetings to implement the use of school facilities during after school hours for Orange County Parks and Recreation Department sponsored programs.
