

RESOLUTION NO. #90-M-05

2 AUTHORIZING APPLICATION BY ORANGE COUNTY TO
3 THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES
4 FOR FLORIDA BOATING IMPROVEMENT FUNDS FOR
5 MAGNOLIA PARK BOAT RAMP FACILITY IMPROVEMENT
6 PROJECT AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING COMMENCEMENT
7 OF THE PROJECT UPON APPROVAL OF SAID
8 APPLICATION.

9 WHEREAS, Section 371.171, Florida Statutes, created a
10 Motorboat Revolving Trust Fund from boat license fees
11 collected within the several counties of Florida; and

12 WHEREAS, it is the intent of the law to return a portion
13 of such fees to the counties from which the said fees were
14 collected, such returned fees to be used for the purposes of
15 improving and developing public launching facilities,
16 dredging and other boating related activities; and

17 WHEREAS, the Orange County Parks and Recreation
18 Department has requested that Orange County make application
19 to the Florida Department of Natural Resources Boating
20 Improvement Program for the construction of boating
21 improvements on Lake Apopka to be known as The Magnolia Park
22 Boat Ramp Facility Improvement Project (hereinafter, the
23 "Project") which improvements will cost an estimated
24 \$190,000.00; and

25 WHEREAS, it is within the intent of the Legislature that
26 the funds for such improvements will come from the said
27 Motorboat Revolving Trust Fund and not from the Orange County
28 General Fund; and

29 WHEREAS, the aforementioned Project will enhance
30 recreational boating on Lake Apopka and thereby be of great
31 benefit to the residents of and visitors to Central Florida.

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
33 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

34 1. The Park Planning and Development Director of the
35 Orange County Parks and Recreation Department is hereby
36 confirmed as the Orange County liaison agent for the Florida
37 Boating Improvement Program and, as such, is hereby
38 authorized to execute and submit the attached application for

1 funds with which to construct the Project and submit the same
2 on behalf of Orange County to the Florida Department of
3 Natural Resources.

4 2. The Parks and Recreational Department is hereby
5 authorized to commence construction of the Project upon
6 approval of the attached application by the Florida
7 Department of Natural Resources.
