A RESOLUTION MODIFYING A SYSTEM OF FINES
PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 85-01, AS AMENDED
BY ORDINANCES NOS. 85-8, 87-14 AND 87-36,
AND RESOLUTION NO. 85-M-01, AS AMENDED BY
RESOLUTION NO. 85-M-39.

PREMISES

A. In an effort to correct problems which have arisen
with regard to parking of motor vehicles within the
unincorporated areas of Orange County, the Board of County
Commissioners has adopted Ordinance No. 85-01, as amended.

B. The Board of County Commissioners has further
amended said Ordinance to prohibit the parking of a vehicle
on the unpaved portion of the right-of-way with a "For Sale"
sign or other indicia of offering the vehicle for sale.

C. Pursuant to said Ordinance, the Board of County
Commissioners has adopted, by Resolution (No. 85-M-01, as
amended), a schedule of fines for parking violations for
which payment may be made in accordance with provisions set
forth within said Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners does hereby
modify the schedule of fines for violations of Ordinance No.
85-01, as amended, relating to parking in Orange County by
adding the following:

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take
effect on April 1, 1990.
