RESOLUTION NO. #90-M-39

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE EXPERIMENTAL
USE OF A VOTING SYSTEM FOR THE 1990 PRIMARY
AND GENERAL ELECTIONS IN ORANGE COUNTY,
FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR LIMITATIONS AND
RESTRICTED USE: AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.

WHEREAS, the Office of Supervisor of Elections for Orange
County, Florida, has recommended that pursuant to Section
101.31, Fla. Stat. (1989), the Board of County Commissioners
authorize the experimental use of a voting system in the
primary and general elections for 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor of Elections has stated that her
office needs additional voting equipment prior to the primary
and general elections to be held in 1990; and

WHEREAS, Orange County is currently in the process of
reviewing various voting systems in order that it may, in the
future, purchase a voting system certified by the Division of
Elections of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners determines
that it is imperative that any experimental use of voting
system be such that, if any problems arise with the use of
the voting system, ballots can be manually counted in order
that election results can be ascertained; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners authorizes the
use of a voting system on an experimental basis only for the
primary and general elections to be held in 1990.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the Supervisor of Elections is hereby
authorized to select a voting system to be used on an
experimental basis for the primary and general elections to
be held in 1990.

Section 2. That the voting system selected by Supervisor
of Election be such that ballots could be counted by hand if
any problems arise.

Section 3. That the Supervisor of Elections shall
immediately proceed with selecting a voting system for
experimental use.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
