RESOLUTION NO. 91-M-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA PERTAINING TO THE ORANGE COUNTY CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILY SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD; AMENDING SECTION 2d OF RESOLUTION NO. 90-M-57 CONCERNING TERMS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 90-M-21 on March 26, 1990, creating the Orange County Children, Youth and Family Services Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 90-M-57 on September 24, 1990 amending Section 2d of Resolution 90-M-21; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners now desires to amend Section 2d of Resolution No. 90-M-57 concerning terms of the members of the Children, Youth and Family Services Advisory Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. TERMS. Section 2d of Resolution No. 90-M-57 is hereby amended as follows:

All initial appointments shall be made for the remainder of the calendar year 1990. In order to achieve continuity through the staggering of terms, appointments which shall commence on ~~January~~ July 1, 1991 shall be made in the following manner: ~~two--(2)~~ three (3) members shall be appointed for a term of one (1) year, ~~and two--(2)~~ four (4) members shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years ~~and three--(3)--members--shall--be appointed--for--a--term--of--three--(3)--years.~~ All subsequent appointments shall be for a term of ~~three--(3)~~ two (2) years. ~~Members shall be eligible for reappointment.~~

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of passage.
