PREMISES

1. On August 6, 1991, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, (the "Board"), adopted an ordinance levying a public service tax upon the purchase of water service at a rate of 10% of the payments received by the seller from the purchaser for the purchase of the service.

2. The City of Winter Park provides water service to customers in unincorporated Orange County at a rate of 1.05 dollars per 1,000 gallons and charges customers located within the city a rate of .84 cents per 1,000 gallons.

3. The Board desires to have the two rates equalized, to the extent possible, such that customers located in the unincorporated area of Orange County will pay the same rate for water service as customers located within the city limits.

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY.

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County respectfully requests the City of Winter Park to remove the surcharge from the purchase of water by its customers located within the unincorporated area of Orange County to the extent the surcharge cannot be attributed to the extra cost incurred to provide service to those customers as supported by a "cost of service study."

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
