RESOLUTION NO. 92-M-19

2 A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ORANGE COUNTY
3 SCHEDULE OF FEES AS TO CERTAIN FEES CHARGED
4 BY THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING
5 SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
6 DATE.

7 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has authority
8 by law to enact and, from time to time, amend fees charged
9 by the various departments of the Orange County Government
10 for various services rendered to the public; and

11 WHEREAS, Orange County can legally charge a fee for such
12 services that captures the reasonable cost associated with
13 administrative, personal services, operating, capital, and
14 overhead to provide that service; and

15 WHEREAS, The Building Department has instituted
16 permitting and inspection of low voltage electrical
17 construction and has estimated its reasonable cost, and
18 certain fees should be implemented as a result of said
19 effort; and

20 WHEREAS, the Office of Management and Budget has
21 recommended that these fees be approved by the Board of
22 County Commissioners as to services rendered or for which
23 application is made on and after April 1, 1992.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
25 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

26 Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby
27 revises the fee schedule for County Government departments

1 shown in the schedule of revised fees attached hereto, marked
2 Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof by this reference.

3 Section 2. All fees set forth in the aforementioned
4 schedule of revised fees shall be effective and enforceable
5 for services rendered by or for which application is made to
6 the respective Departments of the Orange County Government
7 commencing April 1, 1992.

8 Section 3. All other Resolutions or parts of Resolutions
9 establishing fees in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to
10 the extent necessary to give full effect to the terms of this
11 Resolution.

12 Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this
13 Resolution or the application thereof to any person or
14 circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
15 other provisions or applications of this Resolution which can
16 be given effect without the invalid provision or application
17 and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are
18 declared severable.

19 Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take
20 effect immediately upon its adoption.
