RESOLUTION NO. 92-M-24

**A RESOLUTION CONVEYING SURPLUS COUNTY PROPERTY TO THE
UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, GEOLOGICAL
SURVEY, WATER RESOURCES DIVISION**

PREMISES

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County is in receipt of an application from the United States Department of the Interior, Geological Survey, Water Resources Division, for conveyance of One (1) Underground Drilling Rig, which is currently County property, for continued use in the study of ground-water resources.

2. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County finds that said Department of the Interior is a valid governmental agency of the United States.

3. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain surplus property, namely:

One (1) Underground Drilling Rig

which property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

4. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, by virtue of Section 125.38 Florida Statutes, is authorized to convey surplus County property no longer of use to or required by the County, to other governmental agencies of the United States.

5. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, recognizes that the United States Department of the Interior presently has custody of the Underground Drilling Rig and has previously renovated the same at no cost to Orange County.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

1. Orange County shall and hereby does convey, for money spent, the following property to the United States Department of the Interior, Geological Survey Department, Water Resources Division, namely:

One (1) Underground Drilling Rig

2. The United States Department of the Interior, Geological Survey Department, Water Resources Division, will retain custody of and be granted total ownership rights to the Underground Drilling Rig.
