3 A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED
4 LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR FOR THE RESI-
5 DENTIAL DISTRICT KNOWN AS _____
6 Azalea Park-Sections 4, 7 and 8

7 WHEREAS, Section 316.189 and Section 316.183, Florida
8 Statutes, as amended by Chapter 88-47, Laws of Florida,
9 authorizes a county to set a maximum speed limit of 25 miles
10 per hour for a residential district after an investigation
11 determines that such a limit is reasonable; and

12 WHEREAS, Orange County has determined after an investi-
13 gation that the maximum speed limit should be 25 miles per
14 hour for the residential district known as _____
15 Azalea Park-Sections 4, 7 and 8

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
17 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

18 1. The maximum speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour
19 for all streets located within the residential district known
20 as Azalea Park-Sections 4, 7 and 8

21 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon the
22 date of its adoption.
