

RESOLUTION NO. 93-M-43

**A RESOLUTION CONVEYING SURPLUS COUNTY EQUIPMENT TO ORANGE COUNTY
CIVIL BICYCLE PATROL, A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA.**

PREMISE

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County is in receipt of the application of Orange County Civil Bicycle Patrol, for conveyance to it of eight portable two-way radios which are currently County property.
2. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County finds that said Orange County Civil Patrol, is a valid non-profit organization of the State of Florida.
3. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain surplus equipment, namely:

eight portable two-way radios - O.C. #'s
912409,912411,983256,983258,983263,984550,985551,994021

which property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

4. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, by virtue of Section 125.38 Florida Statutes, is authorized to convey surplus County property no longer of use or required by the County, to non-profit organizations of the State of Florida.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
ORANGE COUNTY:

1. Orange County shall and hereby does convey the following property to Orange County Civil Bicycle Patrol, namely:

eight portable two-way radios - O.C. #'s
912409,912411,983256,983258,983263,984550,984551,994021

2. Orange County Civil Bicycle Patrol will remove said property from Orange County Telecommunications at no cost or liability to the County.
