**RESOLUTION TO CONVEY SURPLUS COUNTY EQUIPMENT TO
TO UNITED HUMANITARIANS, INC., A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION
OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA**

PREMISE

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County is in receipt of an application from United Humanitarians, Inc. for conveyance of an autoclave unit, which is currently County property, which will be used to sterilize instruments for the spaying and neutering of animals.
2. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County finds that United Humanitarians, Inc. is a valid non-profit in the State of Florida.
3. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain surplus equipment namely:

One (1) Ansto Autoclave, Model 901, Serial Number 0402389079BB52-2

which said property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

4. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, by virtue of Section 125.38 Florida Statutes, is authorized to convey surplus County property no longer of use or required by the County to non-profit organizations which promote community interest and welfare at a price, nominal or otherwise, that the Board should affix.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

1. Orange County shall and hereby does convey, by donation, the following property to United Humanitarians, Inc., namely:

One (1) Ansto Autoclave, Model 901, Serial Number 0402389079BB52-2

2. The transfer of said property to United Humanitarians, Inc. shall result in no cost or liability to the County.
