

RESOLUTION NO. 95-M-108

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA RECOGNIZING THE SIGNIFICANT COMMUNITY AND ORANGE COUNTY OFFICIALS AND STAFF COMMITMENT TO BRING POSITIVE CHANGE TO THE WINTER GARDEN COMMUNITY THROUGH THE TARGETED COMMUNITY INITIATIVE PROCESS AND APPROVING THE WINTER GARDEN COMMUNITY ACTION PLAN.

WHEREAS, Targeted Community Initiatives (TCI) are designed to facilitate community-based development in specific Orange County communities; and

WHEREAS, communities are targeted based on evidence of substantial economic and social distress, demonstrated signs of historic neglect (relative to County services and resources) and when the community has requested the County's assistance in local revitalization efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Winter Garden community meets these criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Winter Garden residents have attended numerous community meetings over the past eight months, and have shown a commitment to bring positive change to their community; and

WHEREAS, the County Government with the cooperation and participation of the City of Winter Garden elected officials and staff have made a commitment to assist the community in its revitalization efforts; and

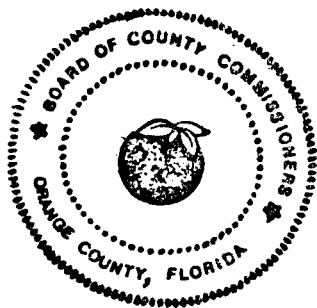
WHEREAS, during the Targeted Community Initiative process, significant citizen involvement and dedication by City of Winter Garden officials and staff and Orange County officials and staff has culminated in the development of the Winter Garden Community Action Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:


That Orange County commends the dedicated commitment to positive change in the Winter Garden community and approves the Winter Garden Community Action Plan (Plan), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners and the Orange County Planning Department and which Plan is incorporated herein by this reference, with the Plan serving as the tool to implement those changes for the

betterment of the community as cited in the Plan and, further, Orange County pledges its continued support toward the revitalization of the Winter Garden community.
