RESOLUTION NO. 97-M-07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ORANGE COUNTY STAFF TO ENTER INTO A HIGHWAY LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR A HIGHWAY BEAUTIFICATION GRANT FOR LEE ROAD FROM EDGEWATER DRIVE TO ALDIRCH AVENUE.

WHEREAS, many roadside areas and median strips abutting Department of Transportation rights-of-way must be maintained and attractively landscaped; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Chairman and Board of County Commissioners desire that Orange County beautify and improve various rights-of-way within Orange County by landscaping; and

WHEREAS, the OrangeScape Committee has ranked beautification projects, AND seeks grant funds from the Florida Department of Transportation to beautify Lee Road from Edgewater Drive to Aldirch Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation requires that Orange County adopt a Resolution as follows, prior to submission of the grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

That Orange County staff is authorized to enter into a Highway Landscaping Maintenance Agreement with the State of Florida Department of Transportation for beautification of Lee Road from Edgewater Drive to Aldirch Avenue.
