RESOLUTION NO. 99-M-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PERTAINING TO THE FLORIDA BOATING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM; DESIGNATING THE ORANGE COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD AS THE OFFICIAL LIASON AGENT BETWEEN ORANGE COUNTY AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION; AUTHORIZING THE ORANGE COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD TO IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER THE FLORIDA BOATING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Orange County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida is authorized by Chapter 16D-5, Florida Administrative Code, to administer the Florida Boating Improvement Program (FBIP) within the County; and

WHEREAS, Orange County is required to designate an "Liaison Agent" who is authorized to act on behalf of the County on all matters pertaining to the FBIP; and

WHEREAS, Orange County is authorized to approve funding from the FBIP for qualified projects submitted by municipalities within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to designate the Orange County Parks and Recreation Advisory Board as the Liaison Agent.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

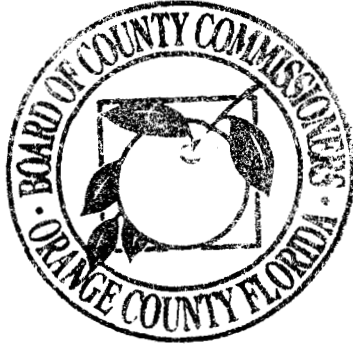
SECTION 1. The Orange County Parks and Recreation Advisory Board is hereby designated as the "Liaison Agent" for Orange County, Florida pursuant to Chapter 16D-5, Florida Administrative Code.

SECTION 2. The Orange County Parks and Recreation Advisory Board shall adopt administrative procedures to implement the Florida Boating Improvement Program. These procedures shall include, at a minimum, project ranking criteria, application

procedures and accountability procedures to ensure that the Program is implemented fairly and efficiently.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of passage.
