BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' DETERMINATION UNDER
SECTION 2, ORDINANCE NO. 79-32.

FINDINGS

1. The Board of County Commissioners has scheduled a public hearing pursuant to Section 153.11(3), Florida Statutes, to consider the adoption of amendments to its Sewer Environmental Conservation Fee Resolution and its Sewer Connection Fee Schedule.
2. The proposed amendments will have an economic impact on development in Orange County.
3. Passage of the amendments will make the County's Sewer Regulations consistent with state standards related to the amount of sewage generated from an equivalent residential unit.
4. Passage of the amendments will also aid the Board in entering into sewer conservation agreements, which help to conserve the scarce commodity of sewage treatment capacity.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners does hereby determine and find, pursuant to Section 2(b), Orange County Ordinance No. 79-32, that sufficient information has been provided for the Board to assess the economic impact of the proposed Resolution amending Sewer Environmental Conservation Fee Resolution dated December 1, 1980, as amended by Resolution dated April 14, 1981, and the Sewer Connection Fee Schedule comprising attachment A of a Resolution adopted January 29, 1980.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners does hereby determine and find that no further economic impact statement or economic impact information is required in this matter.


Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND PUTTING INTO EFFECT AMENDMENTS TO THE SEWER ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION FEE RESOLUTION; ADOPTING AND PUTTING INTO EFFECT AMENDMENTS TO THE SEWER CONNECTION FEE SCHEDULE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

1. The Board of County Commissioners adopted a Sewer Environmental Conservation Fee of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars per equivalent residential unit connection by Resolution dated December 1, 1980, as amended by Resolution dated April 14, 1981.
2. Section 2 of the Sewer Environmental Conservation Fee Resolution provides that for purposes of calculating and imposing the Environmental Conservation Fee, the equivalent residential unit value for any particular connection shall be calculated and imposed in the manner provided for in the Orange County Wastewater and Pollution Control Rate Schedule.
3. It is the Board's intent that the language of Section 2 be amended to clearly indicate that the County Rate Schedule as amended will be used to calculate and impose the Sewer Environmental Conservation Fee.
4. The County's current Sewer Rate Schedule provides that an equivalent residential unit assumes a flow of 350 gallons per day from a single family residential unit.
5. At present, the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation uses a figure of 300 gallons per day as the assumed flow for a single family residential unit connection.
6. The Board wishes for its sewer regulations to be consistent with state standards.
7. The Board set forth preliminary amendments to the Sewer Environmental Conservation Fee Resolution and its Sewer Connection Fee Schedule by Resolution dated July 16, 1981.
8. The Board then scheduled and held, pursuant to Section 153.11(3)(a), Florida Statutes, a public hearing to allow public comment on the preliminary amendments.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Section 2 of the Sewer Environmental Conservation Fee Resolution adopted December 1, 1980, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. For purposes of calculating and imposing the Environmental Conservation Fee provided for in Section 1 above, the equivalent residential unit value for any particular connection shall be calculated and imposed in the manner provided for in the Orange County Wastewater and Pollution Control Rate Schedule, attached as Exhibit 'B', or as that Schedule may be amended from time to time."

Section 2. Section 3(a), page 4, concerning adjusted connection fees in Attachment A of a Resolution adopted January 29, 1980, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(3) ADJUSTED CONNECTION FEES

a. The equivalent residential unit has an assessed value of 1.00. The connection charge for an equivalent residential unit is hereby established as Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars. For the purpose of computing an adjustment of any connection charge within any of the above categories, an equivalent residential unit assumes a flow of three hundred ~~and-fifty-(350)~~ (300) gallons per day from the single family residential unit."

Section 3. A new Section 3(e), page 4, concerning adjusted connection fees in Attachment A of a Resolution adopted January 29, 1980, is hereby adopted to read as follows:

"e. If an applicant for expansion of any building, structure or facilities served by an existing sewer connection within any

of the above categories can demonstrate
to the satisfaction of the Director of
Public Utilities that actual flows will
not increase above the then existing
sewage flows, then the Director of Public
Utilities may apply an Equivalent Residen-
tial Unit Value of zero (0)."


Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect upon adop-
