A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ORANGE COUNTY DIVISION OF PUBLIC UTILITIES DESIGN CRITERIA FOR SUBREGIONAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES; PROVIDING THAT THE DESIGN CRITERIA SHALL BE NON-MANDATORY, ADVISORY GUIDELINES FOR THE PLANNING, DESIGN, FINANCING, AND CONSTRUCTION OF SUBREGIONAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES; PROVIDING FOR COUNTY STAFF AND CONSULTANT ASSISTANCE IN THE PREPARATION OF THE ENGINEER'S REPORT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County owns, operates, and maintains a number of sewerage systems in the unincorporated area of Orange County.
2. The Board finds that many of its present sewerage systems located throughout the County lack adequate reserve treatment and disposal capacity to provide sewer service to potential customers in the County's service area.
3. Pursuant to all applicable general and special law, the Board desires to finance, construct, operate, and maintain any additional sewage treatment and effluent disposal facilities required in its service area.
4. In order to provide adequate sewer service to its service area, the Board intends to initiate a subregional wastewater treatment system construction program in Orange County financed by various funding mechanisms, including the creation of Municipal Service Taxing Units pursuant to Chapter 125, Fla. Stat.
5. In order to produce recommended design criteria for subregional wastewater treatment facilities to be constructed by the County or by private parties for dedication to the County, the Board certified a valid public emergency in order to immediately employ Camp, Dresser, and McKee, Inc., (hereinafter "Consulting Engineers"), by Resolution dated August 13, 1981.
6. The Consulting Engineers completed and submitted a certain document known as the "Orange County Division of Public Utilities Design Criteria for Subregional Wastewater Treatment Facilities" (hereinafter "Subregional Design Criteria") on October 16, 1981.
7. The Subregional Design Criteria are not facility specifications or facility designs, rather, the document provides flexible criteria guidelines for future design activities in Orange County.
8. Since the initial submittal of the Subregional Design Criteria, the County's staff and its Consulting Engineers have met with many concerned parties, engineers, and developers to receive additional input to the document.
9. The Board now desires to adopt the Subregional Design Criteria, as amended or updated by its Consulting Engineers, to be used by the County, however, as only an advisory document for general guidelines in implementing its subregional wastewater treatment system.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Adoption of Design Criteria. The Board of County


Commissioners hereby adopts the Orange County Division of Public Utilities Design Criteria for Subregional Wastewater Treatment Facilities. These design criteria shall be non-mandatory, advisory guidelines only for the planning, design, financing, and construction of subregional wastewater treatment facilities.

Section 2. County Assistance. The Board recognizes that some information required in the Engineer's Report (§1.5 of the Subregional Design Criteria) either has already been generated by the County, or is more easily determinable by the County. Therefore, the Board hereby directs the Division of Public Utilities, the Division of Planning and Development, and any of its sewer and water consulting engineers to provide all possible assistance towards the completion of items 3,5,6,7,8,9,12, and 13 in the Contents of the Engineer's Report, Part B, §1.5, for all engineer reports to be submitted pursuant to §1.5 of the Subregional Design Criteria.


Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
