RESOLUTION NO. 97-SW-03

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 96-SW-01
REPEALING THE AUTOMATIC THREE PERCENT
INCREASE FOR WATER SYSTEM CHARGES
FOR FISCAL YEAR 1998; PROVIDING FOR
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

1. Pursuant to Resolution 96-SW-01, a three percent (3%) increase in Water System Charges is scheduled to take effect on October 1, 1997 for the fiscal year 1998.
2. The Utilities Division of Orange County, Florida has reviewed the current rates and has determined that the existing rates are sufficient to adequately operate the water system for the fiscal year 1998.
3. Based upon this review, the Utilities Division recommends that the automatic three percent (3%) increase in rates for fiscal year 1998 is not necessary and should be repealed.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The automatic three percent (3%) annual rate increase in water system charges scheduled to take effect on October 1, 1997 for fiscal year 1998 pursuant to Resolution No. 96-SW-01 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Resolution 96-SW-01 shall continue in full force and effect in all other respects and unless future resolutions are adopted, the automatic annual increase shall resume as provided on October 1, 1998 for fiscal year 1999.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
