RESOLUTION NO. 2002-SW-06

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FEE  
SCHEDULE FOR OIL AND GREASE PROGRAM CHARGES

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County establishes and collects rates, fees and charges for its Wastewater System pursuant to its home rule powers granted to the County by the Florida Constitution, the Orange County Charter, Chapter 125 of Florida Statutes and any other applicable statutory authority.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners last adopted a revised Orange County Wastewater and Pollution Control Charge Schedule on May 14, 1996, and amended the Orange County Wastewater and Pollution Control Charge Schedule on October 10, 2000 for Septage Disposal Charges, notwithstanding automatic annual adjustments to the same.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has analyzed and caused to be prepared the cost of administering the Oil and Grease Program.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners now desires to adopt the recommendation for charges associated with the Oil and Grease Program.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Revised Wastewater and Pollution Control Charge Schedule. The Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts the Orange County Wastewater and Pollution Control Charge Schedule for Oil and Grease Program Charges attached hereto and incorporated in this Resolution as Exhibit "A". The attached schedule supersedes and hereby repeals the presently existing fee schedule only and to the extent this Resolution applies to Oil and Grease Program Charges. The remaining portions of the existing Orange County Wastewater and Pollution Control Charge Schedule adopted May 14, 1996, in Resolution No. 96-S-03 and amended October 10, 2000 in Resolution No. 2000-M-43 shall remain in full force and effect.



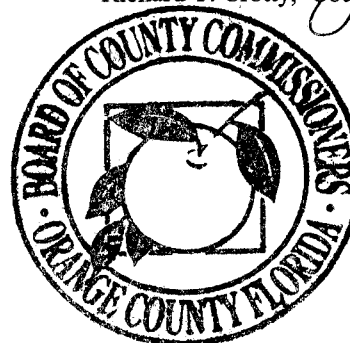
