RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2005-M-29  
REPEALING THE AUTOMATIC THREE PERCENT  
INCREASE FOR RECLAIMED WATER RATES  
FOR THE COMMERCIAL CITRUS GROWERS  
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007;  
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2005-M-29, a three percent (3%) increase in Reclaimed Water Rates for the Commercial Citrus Growers is scheduled to take effect on October 1, 2006 for the fiscal year 2007; and,

WHEREAS, the Utilities Department of Orange County, Florida has reviewed the current rates and has determined that the existing rates are sufficient to adequately operate the reclaimed water system for the fiscal year 2007; and,

WHEREAS, based upon this review, the automatic three percent (3%) increase in rates for fiscal year 2007 is not necessary and the Utilities Department recommends that it be repealed.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

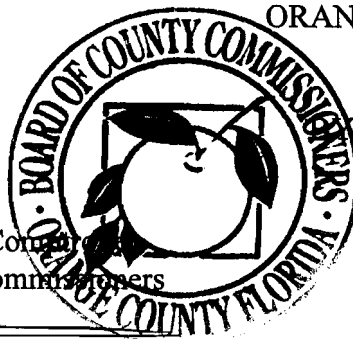
Section 1. The automatic three percent (3%) annual rate increase in Reclaimed Water Rates for the Commercial Citrus Growers scheduled to take effect on October 1, 2006 for fiscal year 2007 pursuant to Resolution No. 2005-M-29 is hereby repealed for this fiscal year.

Section 2. Resolution 2005-M-29 shall continue in full force and effect in all other respects.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
