

JOINT RESOLUTION OF ORANGE COUNTY AND CITY OF ORLANDO
ON
SEWER PLANNING COORDINATION

WHEREAS, the City of Orlando, a municipal corporation created pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "City", and Orange County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County", furnish wastewater collection and treatment services; and,

WHEREAS, many environmental, financial and other problems are seriously inhibiting the ability of the County and the City to serve the wastewater needs of Central Florida; and,

WHEREAS, both the sewer system of the County and the sewer system of the City are similar in general function and design and are subject to similar operating and planning problems and possible solutions; and,

WHEREAS, a free flow of information between the officials and staff of the County and the City about their sewer operations, problems and possible solutions thereto may produce a more efficient and less costly result for the citizens of both Orlando and Orange County;

NOW, THEREFORE, both the City Council of the City of Orlando and the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County resolve:

1. That it is the desire of both the City and the County that the County Administrator, the Chief Administrative Officer of the City, the Director of Public Works of the City, the Director of Public Utilities of the County, the County Attorney, the City Attorney, and all their staffs, fully disclose to each other all their ideas and plans for transporting and treating sewage and disposing of effluent, and the status of such ideas and plans; and,

2. That such officials and staffs make all reasonable efforts to reach mutually agreeable solutions to the current problems confronting the sewer operations of the City and the County and jointly consider how best to meet the future sewer requirements of the County and the City in the most efficient and economical manner consistent with protecting environmental quality.
