RESOLUTION NO. 82-SW-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO FILE A PETITION FOR INTERVENTION INTO THE MATTER OF THE FISCAL YEAR 1983 PRIORITY LIST ADMINISTRATIVE CHALLENGE FILED BY THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

1. The Environmental Regulation Commission adopted rules pursuant to Chapter 120, Fla. Stat., codified as Chapter 17-50, Fla. Admin. Code, for the purpose of establishing a priority list for the allocation of federal wastewater construction grants.

2. Orange County and the city of Orlando received ^{at} high priority scores for their joint Southwest 201 project and were included on the fundable portion of the list.

3. The City of Hollywood filed an administrative challenge to the Environmental Regulation Commission's adoption of the priority list.

4. If the City of Hollywood prevails, it might cause Orange County and the City of Orlando to lose their current status as being within the fundable portion of the priority list.

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. AUTHORIZATION. The Board hereby authorizes the County Attorney to file a Petition to Intervene, either separately or in concert with the City of Orlando, for the purpose of intervening into the administrative challenge to the Fiscal Year 1983 Priority List filed by the City of Hollywood. The County Attorney is further authorized to take all necessary steps and file such documents as shall protect the interests of the County and/or City of Orlando.


Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
