RESOLUTION NO. 82-SW-26

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A REVISED WATER SYSTEM CHARGE SCHEDULE; ADOPTING A CONTINUING ANNUAL THREE PERCENT RATE INCREASE; INCREASING COUNTY WATER CONNECTION FEES; PROVIDING FOR TIME OF PAYMENT OF WATER CONNECTION FEES; RECOGNIZING CONTRIBUTIONS IN AID OF CONSTRUCTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A REPEALER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

1. The Board of County Commissioners last adopted a revised Water System Charge Schedule on January 16, 1982.

2. Since the 1982 rate increase and subsequent automatic annual rate increase of October 1, 1982, the Board has determined that it must increase its water connection fees.

3. The Board adopted a Preliminary Resolution dated November 30, 1982, which set forth preliminary revisions to the current water connection fees.

4. The Board authorized and scheduled a public hearing to consider the rate consultant's report and adoption of the revised Water System Charge Schedule.

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Revised Water System Charge Schedule. The Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts the revised Water System Charge Schedule attached to and incorporated in this Resolution as Exhibit "A". The attached schedule supersedes the presently existing Water System Charge Schedule adopted January 26, 1982.

Section 2. Automatic Annual Rate Increase. Consistent with and pursuant to Section 153.11(3)(c), Fla. Stat., the Board hereby adopts, effective October 1, 1983, and on October 1st of each year thereafter, an annually recurring three percent (3%) increase to all rates, fees, and charges contained in the most current water system charge schedule, in effect immediately prior to each annual increase. On the effective date of each annual increase, the Board hereby directs that the attached revised water system charge schedule shall be further revised to include the three percent (3%) increase, and that a corrected copy of the Water System Charge Schedule be maintained for public inspection by the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 3. Water Connection Fees; Time of Payment. Beginning on the effective date of this Resolution, all meter fees,

meter installation fees, and capacity demand charges shall be paid prior to the issuance of a building permit for a structure or structures to be served by the County's water system. All those who, on the effective date of this Resolution, have received building permits for a structure or structures to be served by the County's water system but have not yet paid applicable meter fees, meter installation fees, and capacity demand charges shall pay applicable meter fees, meter installation fees, and capacity demand charges prior to connection. Said fees and charges shall be determined pursuant to the Water System Charge Schedule, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

Section 4. Capacity Demand Charges; Contributions in Aid of Construction. The Board may exempt any customer from the payment of any portion of the capacity demand charge to the extent that the Board accepts a contribution in aid of construction having a value, determined by the County, of not less than the portion of the capacity demand charge being exempted.

Section 5. Severability of Provisions. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

Section 6. Repealer. The provisions and attached Water System Charge Schedule of the Board's Resolution adopted January 26, 1982, are hereby repealed upon the effective date of this Resolution.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Resolution and attached schedule shall take effect on February 15, 1983, at 12:01 a.m.



BILLING PERIODS

Monthly: Single-family residential, duplex, condominium, and other type dwelling units individually metered; multi-family residential apartment, mobile home, travel-trailer, and other type dwelling units collectively metered; and all other commercial, institutional, industrial or other accounts (e.g., large consumers), regardless of meter size, shall be billed for the amount of water used each month as measured by each of their respective meters. (The above rates shall apply to each meter, regardless of the number of meters).

NOTE: Following satisfactory completion of the water supply and distribution system, and upon receipt of the applicable meter/connection fee, the County shall furnish and install the necessary fittings, meter, and meter box at the property line. The owner or developer of the property desiring service shall bear the expense of the service lateral pipe of the required size, from and including its connection with a corporation stop at the water distribution main in the right-of-way to and including a curb stop at the property line. Service piping from the meter to the building is to be installed by and/or the expense of the property owner or builder.

- (1) A minimum volume charge of \$2.73 shall be levied on all bills for consumption of 3,000 gallons or less.
- (2) The County shall determine the appropriate meter size for use by all its customers.
- (3) Based upon AWWA Standards C700 and C701.
- (4) Does not include any cost associated with construction of a water lateral from the meter to the water main providing service; in the majority of cases, the developer constructs the lateral. In situations where the County would be responsible for the lateral, the cost of the lateral would be charged to the customer on a time, materials, and pro rata overhead cost basis.
- (5) Approximates an average 2-month residential water bill.
- (6) Based upon same ratio as current deposit.
