

RESOLUTION NO. 82-SW-27

ECONOMIC IMPACT DETERMINATION
WATER CONNECTION FEES

FINDINGS

1. The Board is considering an increase in its meter fees, meter installation fees, and capacity demand charges.
2. The increase of said fees will have an economic impact on the development of real property in Orange County.
3. The Board's rate consultants have advised it that this increase is just, reasonable, and necessary in order to manage the County's water system.

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners does hereby determine and find, pursuant to §2(B), Orange County Ordinance No. 79-32, codified as §1-27(b), Orange County Code, that sufficient information has been provided for the Board to assess the economic impact of the proposed Resolution increasing meter fees, meter installation fees, and capacity demand charges on the development of real property in Orange County.

Section 2. The Board does hereby determine and find that no further economic impact statement or economic impact information is required in this matter.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
