

RESOLUTION NO. 82-SW-30

ECONOMIC IMPACT DETERMINATION  
REVENUE AND MAINTENANCE FEE

FINDINGS

1. The Board is considering the adoption of a Revenue and Maintenance Fee to be paid annually by all customers wishing to reserve capacity for a period exceeding one year.

2. The charging of a Revenue and Maintenance Fee is intended to recover a portion of the fixed costs associated with maintaining service capacity for certain customers.

3. The adoption of such a fee will have an economic impact on the development of real property in Orange County.

4. Based upon the advice of its rate consultant, the Board has determined that the Revenue and Maintenance Fee must be charged in order to more fairly and reasonably allocate the fixed costs of operating and maintaining the Orange County Wastewater System.

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners does hereby determine and find, pursuant to §1-27(b), Orange County Code, that sufficient information has been provided for the Board to assess the economic impact of the proposed Ordinance adopting a Revenue and Maintenance Fee on the development of real property in Orange County.

Section 2. The Board does hereby determine and find that no further economic impact statement or economic impact information is required in this matter.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
