RESOLUTION NO. 82-31

ECONOMIC IMPACT DETERMINATION  
EASTERN SUBREGIONAL SEWER SERVICE  
ALLOCATION RULES

FINDINGS

1. The Board is considering the adoption of an ordinance establishing a sewer service allocation system for its Eastern Subregional Wastewater System.

2. The adoption of such an allocation system will have an economic impact on the development of real property in Orange County.

3. The Board has determined that the adoption of this sewer service allocation system is necessary to fairly and equitably allocate excess sewer service capacity within the Eastern Subregional Wastewater System.

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The Board does hereby determine and find, pursuant to Section 1-27(b), Orange County Code, that sufficient information has been provided for the Board to assess the economic impact of the proposed ordinance adopting the Eastern Subregional Sewer Service allocation rules on the development of real property in Orange County.

Section 2. The Board does hereby determine and find that no further economic impact statement or economic impact information is required in this matter.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
