A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH ALL THOSE APPLICANTS FOR TYPE "B" PERMITS AND ALL THOSE PERSONS, FIRMS, OR CORPORATIONS ELIGIBLE FOR TYPE "C" PERMITS MAY PAY APPLICABLE SEWER CAPITAL CHARGES BY JULY 8, 1983; PROVIDING FOR THE POSTING OF A LETTER OF CREDIT IN AN APPROPRIATE AMOUNT AS A CONDITION TO RECEIVING THE EXTENSION; PROVIDING FINDING; PROVIDING AN ECONOMIC IMPACT DETERMINATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY OF PROVISIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Findings of the Board of County Commissioners.

The Board hereby finds and determines, pursuant to §5(i), Sand Lake Road Wastewater Treatment Plant Connection Rules, as amended, that inequities exist and a hardship would be created unless it further extends the time for payment of applicable Sewer Capital Charges as required in the first County Letters of Eligibility previously sent to all those applicants for Type "B" Permits and all those persons, firms, or corporations eligible to receive Type "C" Permits, and as required by Subsection 5(c)(1), Sand Lake Road Wastewater Treatment Plant Connection Rules, as amended, for Sewer Service Capacity created by the 3 MGD Effluent Disposal Project. The Board further finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Orange County, the customers of the Orange County Wastewater System, and the potential customers of said system to extend said date for payment of applicable Sewer Capital Charges, provided the conditions of this Resolution are complied with.

Section 2. Extension of Time for Payment of Fees. The Board hereby extends to July 8, 1983, the date by which payment of applicable Sewer Capital Charges by all those applicants for Type "B" Permits and all those persons, firms, or corporations eligible for Type "C" Permits must be made to purchase Sewer Service Capacity created by the 3 MGD Project, as required in the first County Letters of Eligibility previously sent by the County to said applicants, persons, firms, or corporations and as required by Subsection 5(c)(1), Sand Lake Road Wastewater Treatment Plant Connection Rules, as amended; provided, however, this extension shall apply to only those applicants,

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persons, firms, or corporations (or their agents) that have delivered necessary Letters of Credit in an amount and a form acceptable to the County in accordance with the first County Letters of Eligibility previously sent to said applicants, persons, firms, or corporations by July 6, 1983.

Section 3. Economic Impact Determination. The Board does hereby determine and find, pursuant to §1-27(2)(b), Orange County Code, that sufficient information has been provided for the Board to assess the economic impact of this Resolution on the development of real property in Orange County. The Board does hereby determine and find that no further economic impact statement or economic impact information is required in this matter.

Section 4. Severability of Provisions. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end, the provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
