RESOLUTION NO. 83-SW-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA; DESIGNATING THE OAK MEADOWS SERVICE AREA AND THE RIVERSIDE-MEADOWBROOK SERVICE AREA AS PARTICULAR SERVICE AREAS TO WHICH THE BOARD INTENDS TO ALLOCATE WATER SERVICE CAPACITY; DESIGNATING AN ALLOCATION DATE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County has adopted the Orange County Water Service Allocation Rules by Ordinance on July 18, 1983.

2. The Board intends to construct or expand potable water facilities owned or to be owned by the Board.

3. Section 3, Orange County Water Service Allocation Rules, authorizes the Board to designate a particular service area of geographic location to which it intends to provide and allocate water service capacity created by the construction or expansion of potable water facilities.

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The Board hereby designates, pursuant to Section 3, Orange County Water Service Allocation Rules, the Oak Meadows Service Area and the Riverside-Meadowbrook Service Area, described in Composite Exhibit "A" attached to and incorporated in this Resolution as particular service areas to which the Board intends to provide and allocate water service capacity created by the construction or expansion of potable water facilities.

Section 2. The Board hereby designates an "Allocation Date" for July 29, 1983, for the allocation of water service capacity by the construction or expansion of potable water facilities owned or to be owned by the County to the Oak Meadows and Riverside-Meadowbrook Service Areas. The Board further authorizes the Clerk to publish notice of said designations in a newspaper of general circulation in Orange County.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.

AN AREA LOCATED WEST OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, WITH AN EXTENSION OF THE ORLANDO UTILITIES COMMISSION BOUNDARY ON THE NORTH, ALONG SILVER STAR ROAD, WEST OF HIAWASSEE ROAD; BY AN EXTENSION OF THE ORLANDO CITY LIMITS ON THE SOUTHEAST PORTION EXTENDING TO OLD WINTER GARDEN ROAD ON THE SOUTHWEST; AND BY A NORTH-SOUTH LINE LOCATED BETWEEN LAKE OLYMPIA AND LAKE LOTTA ON THE WEST. EXCLUDING OAK MEADOWS, UNITS 1, 2, 3; VILLAS OF OAK MEADOWS, PHASE II AND III; CINNAMON BAY, PHASE I; AND JACARANDA SUBDIVISIONS.

RIVERSIDE WATER SERVICE AREA

AN AREA LOCATED NORTHWEST OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO WITH SEMINOLE COUNTY BEING THE NORTH BOUNDARY; BY THE URBAN SERVICE AREA LINE ON THE WEST; BY AN EXTENSION OF THE ORLANDO UTILITIES COMMISSION AND THE WINTER PARK UTILITIES WATER SERVICE BOUNDARIES ON THE SOUTH; AND BY THE CITY OF MAITLAND ON THE EAST.
