DISSOLVING THE JOINT STUDY COMMISSION  
ON SEWER AND WATER SERVICES

WHEREAS, the CITY OF ORLANDO, a municipal corporation created pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "City", and ORANGE COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County", both own and operate sewer and water systems located in Orange County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City and County made and entered into an Agreement, dated December 10, 1981, entitled "Orange County/City of Orlando Wastewater Study Commission"; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement provided for the appointment of an independent Citizens Commission, comprised of seven (7) non-elected officials, to review and study the sewer and water systems operations of the City and County, the problems involved and possible solutions; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement provided for City and County staff cooperation and financial support for reasonable operating expenses of the Citizens Commission; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement provided for completion of a report and recommendations by the Citizens Commission within six (6) months of the date on which all seven (7) members were appointed; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement provided for public meetings of the Citizens Commission; and

1       WHEREAS, seven (7) officials were duly appointed as members  
2 of the independent Joint Study Commission on Sewer and Water  
3 Services for Orlando and Orange County; and

4       WHEREAS, said Commission conducted regular public meetings  
5 in Orange County, Florida, beginning February 1, 1982; and

6       WHEREAS, said Commission reviewed and studied the sewer and  
7 water systems operations of the City and County, the problems  
8 involved and possible solutions; and

9       WHEREAS, said Commission received City and County staff  
10 cooperation and financial support for reasonable operating  
11 expenses; and

12       WHEREAS, said Commission issued a report and recom-  
13 mendations, entitled "Report of the Joint Study Commission on  
14 Sewer and Water Services for Orlando and Orange County", dated  
15 June 15, 1982, as amended by the letter of the Joint Study  
16 Commission, dated July 27, 1982 (the "Report of the Joint Study  
17 Commission");

18       NOW, THEREFORE, both the City Council of the City of  
19 Orlando and the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County  
20 resolve:

21       1. That the Joint Study Commission on Sewer and Water  
22 Services for Orlando and Orange County, having completed its  
23 review and report, is hereby officially dissolved; and

24       2. That the City and County express appreciation to the  
25 officials who served as members of the Joint Study Commission;

2 staff who rendered assistance to the Joint Study Commission.
