ORANGE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 84-SW-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA; ESTABLISHING A UTILITY FACILITY PERMIT APPLICATION FEE OF ONE THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED (\$1,300.00) DOLLARS; PROVIDING AN ECONOMIC IMPACT DETERMINATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

1. The Board adopted the Orange County Water and Wastewater Facilities Permit Rules, Orange County Ordinance No. 83-40, on October 31, 1983 (hereafter "Rules").

2. The Rules require all persons desiring to construct water treatment, wastewater treatment, or effluent disposal facilities to apply for and obtain a Utility Facility Permit therefor.

3. Section 4(3) of the Rules authorizes the Board by County Resolution to establish the amount of a non-returnable application fee for Utility Facility Permit applications.

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

SECTION 1. UTILITY FACILITY PERMIT APPLICATION FEE.

The Board hereby establishes a Utility Facility Permit Application Fee of one thousand, three hundred (\$1,300.00) dollars which shall be collected from any person filing a Utility Facility Permit Application on or after January 1, 1985.

SECTION 2. ECONOMIC IMPACT DETERMINATION. The Board

does hereby determine and find, pursuant to Section 1-27(2)(b), Orange County Code, that sufficient information has been provided for the Board to assess the economic impact of this Resolution on the development of real property in Orange County, Florida. The Board does hereby determine and find that no further economic impact statement or economic impact information is required in this matter.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Ordinance


or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
